## ORDINANCE NO. 271

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMPTON, NEBRASKA TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL CODE, CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE I, 5-107, (c), (e), TO PERMIT THE SALE OF DISTILLED SPIRITS FOR CONSUMPTION ON PREMISES FROM NOON SUNDAY TO TWELVE O'CLOCK MIDNIGHT SUNDAY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMPTON, NEBRASKA:

Section No. 1 (c) No person shall, within the village, sell at retail or dispense for consumption on the premises any alcoholic liquor except beer and wine on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, between the hours of six o'clock a.m. Sunday and noon Sunday.

(e) It shall be lawful to sell at retail or dispense beer for consumption on or off the premises on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, between the hours of six o'clock a.m. Sunday and twelve o'clock midnight Sunday, and to sell for consumption on the premises wine and alcoholic liquor from noon Sunday until twelve o'clock midnight Sunday.

Section No. 2. That all other ordinances and other resolutions or parts of ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section No. 3. It is the intention of the governing body, and it is hereby ordained, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made part of the Code of the Village of Hampton, Nebraska, and the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish this intention.

Section No. 4. The governing body hereby finds, determines, and declares that the provisions of this Ordinance shall be prepared in pamphlet form and notice thereof posted in three places in the Village of Hampton, Nebraska, and shall take effect immediately upon such posting.
