

# Nebraska Liquor Control Commission—Licensing News July 2020

### **RENEWALS NON-CLASS C:**

Renewal Publication Reminder - Class "C" Licenses:

Retail licenses renewal: notice.

The city, village, or county clerk shall cause to be published in a legal newspaper in or of general circulation in such city, village, or county, one time between January 10 and January 30 of each year, individual notice of the right of automatic renewal of each retail liquor and beer license, except that notice of the right of automatic renewal of Class C licenses shall be published between the dates of July 10 and July 30 of each year within such city, village, or county, in substantially the following form:

#### NOTICE OF RENEWAL OF RETAIL LIQUOR LICENSE

Notice is hereby given pursuant to section  $\underline{53-135.01}$  that a liquor license may be automatically renewed for one year from May 1, 20...., or **November 1, 20....**, for the following retail liquor licensee:

(Name of Licensee) (Address of licensed premises)

Notice is hereby given that written protests to the issuance of automatic renewal of license may be filed by any resident of the city (village or county) on or before February 10, 20...., or August 10, 20...., in the office of the city (village or county) clerk and that in the event protests are filed by three or more such persons, hearing will be had to determine whether continuation of the license should be allowed.

Upon the conclusion of any hearing required by this section, the local governing body may request a licensee to submit an application as provided in section <u>53-135</u>.

Please encourage licensees to renew online. You may check to see if a licensee has renewed by going to our search page https://www.nebraska.gov/nlcc/license\_search/licsearch.cgi entering the license number, scrolling to the bottom of the screen under history, and then looking for a "RENEW APP." code for 2020. If nothing is found, they have not submitted their renewal to our office.

## SPECIAL DESIGNATED LICENSES & CANCELLED EVENTS:

Please note we are still processing SDL applications. However, the applicant will need to check with the local health department and your office to make sure all health directives are followed. If the event would be cancelled, the applicant can follow the directions below. This information is also found at the bottom of the SDL page. There are no refunds for SDL applications once they are entered.

# COVID-19 virus and the cancellation of events:

Please see procedures below for issued SDL licenses that are being cancelled or rescheduled. The normal process of the NLCC is to not amend an SDL license once it has been issued.

# ⇒ Cancelled events with no rescheduled date:

Prior to the date of the event, applicant will need to return the original license in the mail along with a letter of cancellation. This license must be postmarked or received by our office prior to the date of the event.

Once license is received by the NLCC, the license will be marked as cancelled, and it will not be counted against the SDL counts for the licensee or location for the calendar year.

⇒ Cancelled events to add alternate date or change original alternate date:

Prior to the date of the event, applicant will need to return the original license in the mail along with a local recommendation letter or amended Form 200 approved by the Clerk to include the newly added or changed alternate date of event. This license must be postmarked or received by our office prior to the date of the event.

An amended license will be emailed to the Clerk upon receipt of these two items.

Please note: As noted in the SDL instructions found on the NLCC website, there are no refunds for cancelled SDL licenses.
