To Whom It May Concern,

Chase County, Nebraska is the owner of the Chase County Fairgrounds facility located at 560 Park St Imperial, NE. The Fairgrounds is an 80-acre area with an arena and numerous buildings used for various events. All using the same address. The Fairgrounds is the host of the Chase County Fair, numerous rodeos, barrel races, tractor pulls, and is a main venue for weddings, graduations, fundraisers and quinceaneras. Due to our population, Chase County has a very limited number of venues to host events, making Chase County Fairgrounds one of the main places utilized by the community for such occasions. Due to the fairgrounds hosting numerous community events throughout the year which requires SDL's we have reached the 12 SDL limit. We have many events planned for the remainder of the year. Chase County Fairgrounds uses the same address for all events and at this time would not be allowed to have additional SDLs for the remainder of the year. It is the opinion of the Commissioners that it would not be in the best interest of the community for Chase County to apply for a liquor license. We do not have the ability to run a business or to staff a bar. The Chase County Commissioners are respectfully asking the NLCC Commissioners to consider adding the Chase County Fairgrounds to the 12+ SDL per year list.
