ORDINANCE NO. 2017-2950

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 111 - ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; SECTION 111.01 HOURS OF SALE OF THE CITY OF MCCOOK CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ANY AND ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING A TIME AND DATE FROM AND AFTER WHICH THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE ENFORCED.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCCOOK, NEBRASKA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That Chapter 111 - Alcoholic Beverages, Section 111.01 <u>Hours of Sale;</u> shall be amended to read as follows:

"§ 111.01 HOURS OF SALE.

(A) It shall be unlawful for any licensed person or persons or his, her or their agents to sell any alcoholic beverages within the municipality except during the hours provided herein:

HOURS OF SALE

Alcoholic Liquors (except beer and wine)

Secular Days

Off Sale 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. On Sale 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m.

Sundays

Off Sale 12:00 p.m. to 1.00 a.m. On Sale 12:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m.

Beer and Wine

Secular Days

Off Sale 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. On Sale 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m.

Sundays

Off Sale 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. On Sale 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m.

(B) No person or persons shall consume any alcoholic beverages on licensed premises for a period of time longer than 15 minutes after the time fixed herein for stopping the sale of alcoholic beverages on the premises. For the purposes of this section, ON SALE shall be defined as alcoholic beverages sold by the drink for consumption on the premises of the licensed establishment; OFF SALE shall be defined as alcoholic beverages sold at retail in the original container for consumption off the premises of the licensed establishment.

(C) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit licensed premises from being open for other business on days and hours during which the sale or dispensing of alcoholic beverages is prohibited by this section."

<u>SECTION 2</u>. Any and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication as required by law in its entirety or in pamphlet form, as the case may be or on October 1, 2017 whichever is last.
