IMPORTANT RENEWAL PUBLICATION NOTICE

All Non-Class C liquor Licenses will expire May 1, 2019. Therefore, licensees will need to be renewed by April 30, 2019.

As clerk, you are responsible to fulfill the renewal notice requirements as set forth in sec. 53-135.01 of the Liquor Control Act.

Publication should be made one time between January 10, 2019 and January 30, 2019 in a legal newspaper or general circulation in your city, town or county. You are not required to file a copy of the notice with the Liquor Commission.

Renewal Forms will be mailed to you the first week of February to distribute to your license holders and keep on file. Please encourage licensees to renew promptly and use the ON-LINE RENEWAL OPTION located on our website.

53-135.01. Retail licenses; renewal; notice.

The city, village, or county clerk shall cause to be published in a legal newspaper in or of general circulation in such city, village, or county, one time between January 10 and January 30 of each year.

NOTICE OF RENEWAL OF RETAIL LIQUOR LICENSE

Notice is hereby given pursuant to section 53-135.01 that a liquor license may be automatically renewed for one year from May 1, 2019 for the following retail liquor licensee:

Notice is hereby given that written protests to the issuance of automatic renewal of license may be filed by any resident of the city (village or county) on or before February 10, 2019 in the office of the city (village or county) clerk and that in the event protests are filed by three or more such persons, hearing will be had to determine whether continuation of the license should be allowed.

Form #200 should always be completely filled out prior to your approval. Dates, times, alternate location must be present on the form before your review.
