Renewal Publication Reminder - Class "C" Licenses:.

Retail licenses renewal; notice.

The city, village, or county clerk shall cause to be published in a legal newspaper in or of general circulation in such city, village, or county, one time between January 10 and January 30 of each year, individual notice of the right of automatic renewal of each retail liquor and beer license, except that notice of the right of automatic renewal of Class C licenses shall be published between the dates of July 10 and July 30 of each year within such city, village, or county, in substantially the following form:

NOTICE OF RENEWAL OF RETAIL LIQUOR LICENSE

Notice is hereby given pursuant to section <u>53-135.01</u> that a liquor license may be automatically renewed for one year from May 1, 20...., or **November 1, 20....**, for the following retail liquor licensee:

Notice is hereby given that written protests to the issuance of automatic renewal of license may be filed by any resident of the city (village or county) on or before February 10, 20...., or August 10, 20...., in the office of the city (village or county) clerk and that in the event protests are filed by three or more such persons, hearing will be had to determine whether continuation of the license should be allowed.

Upon the conclusion of any hearing required by this section, the local governing body may request a licensee to submit an application as provided in section <u>53-135</u>.

Please encourage licensees to renew online. You may check to see if a licensee has renewed by going to our search page https://www.nebraska.gov/nlcc/license_search/licsearch.cgi entering the license number, scrolling to the bottom of the screen under history, and then looking for a "RENEW APP." code for 2018. If nothing is found, they have not submitted their renewal to our office.

Special Designated License News:

As previously mentioned, the Nebraska Legislature has approved a bill that will affect Special Designate Licenses. With the statute change, two items will be affected:

- ◆ SDL licenses will be able to be electronically delivered to the local governing body effective September 1st.
- ◆The Local governing body would be able to create an expedite process for licensed caterers that would normally need to have the application into their office a minimum of 21-days. If expedite process is used, the deadline will be at least 12-days prior to the event for emergency applications. This change will not affect the 10-day NLCC rule.

Since we will not be mailing the licenses, we will be creating an order form for SDL packets (posters) for your offices. If you are able to pickup a supply of posters at our office when in the area, we would appreciate you stopping and obtaining packets for your licensees. Otherwise, they will be mailed. We want to stress that reusing these posters by caterers or frequent users of SDL licenses is highly recommended.

Please email our office if there are any corrections/changes to your email address. This will be the point of contact for electronic delivery of these licenses.
