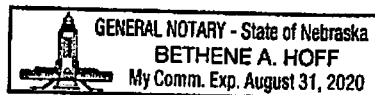

ORDINANCE NO. 5646

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORFOLK, NEBRASKA TO AMEND SECTION 3-5 OF THE OFFICIAL CITY CODE TO ALLOW THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR ON ANY DAY FROM 6:00 A.M. UNTIL 2:00 A.M. THE FOLLOWING DAY; TO PROVIDE WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT; AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORFOLK, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Section 3-5 of the Official City Code be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 3-5. Hours of sale on Sunday.

(a) Consumption off the premises.

Alcoholic liquor, including beer and wine, may be sold for consumption off the premises where sold, on ~~Sunday between the hours of 6:00 a.m. Sunday and 1:00 a.m. Monday~~ any day from 6:00 a.m. until 2:00 a.m. the following day.

(b) Consumption on the premises.

Alcoholic liquors, including beer and wine for consumption on the premises may be sold at retail or dispensed ~~between the hours of 6:00 a.m. Sunday and 1:00 a.m. Monday~~ on any day from 6:00 a.m. until 2:00 a.m. the following day.

Section 2. That this Ordinance was approved by a two-thirds vote of the members of the City Council as required by *Nebraska Revised Statutes*, §53-179.

Section 3. That the effective date of this Ordinance shall be from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
