ORDINANCE NO. 193

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BRUNING, THAYER COUNTY, NEBRASKA, RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS; TO AMEND CHAPTER SIX (6), SECTION FOUR (4) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF BRUNING; TO REGULATE THE TIME OF SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS; AND TO PROVIDE AN OPERATIVE DATE.

Be it ordained by the Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bruning:

Section 1 That Chapter Six (6), Section Four (4) of the Municipal Code of the Village of Bruning, Thayer County, Nebraska, be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 4. (1) RETAIL SALES, BY THE PACKAGE, LIMIT. No person, corporation or other entity, shall within the Village sell any alcoholic liquors by the package between the hours of 1:00 o'clock A.M. and 6:00 o'clock A.M., on any day.

Sec. 4. (2) RETAIL SALES, BY THE DRINK, LIMIT. No person, corporation or other entity, shall within the Village sell any alcoholic liquors by the drink between the hours of 2:00 o'clock A.M. and 6:00 o'clock A.M., on any day.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall become operative from and after its approval and publication as provided by law.
