A RESOLUTION TO MODIFY DORCHESTER REVISED MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 10-117, REGARDING HOURS OF SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN THE CITY LIMITS, AND INCREASING THOSE HOURS TO MATCH THE HOURS PRESCRIBED BY NEBRASKA LAW.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF TE VILLAGE OF DORCHESTER, NEBRASKA:

Hours of Sale: The hours of sale listed in Revised Municipal Code Section 10-117 (A) are hereby changed to end at 2 a.m. on all days were alcoholic liquor and beer and wine are sold in the Village of Dorchester.

All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby changed to match the hours in (1) above. This change in hours of sale will take effect immediately, subject to passage, publication and notice requirements as provided for by law.

SECTION 10-117: HOURS OF SALE

(A) It shall be unlawful for any licensed person or persons or their agents to sell any alcoholic beverages within the Village except during the hours provided herein:

Alcoholic Liquors (except Beer and Wine)	
<i>Monday through Saturday</i>	
Off Sale	6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m.
On Sale	6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m.
<i>Sunday</i>	
Off Sale	12:00 noon to 1:00 a.m.
On Sale	12:00 noon to 1:00 a.m.
Beer and Wine	
<i>Daily</i>	
Off Sale	6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m.
On Sale	6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m.

(B) Such limitations shall not apply after 12:00 noon on Sunday to a licensee which is a nonprofit corporation holding a license pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §53-124(5)(C) & (H).

(C) No person or persons shall consume any alcoholic beverages on licensed premises for a period of time longer than 15 minutes after the time fixed herein for stopping the sale of alcoholic beverages on the said premises. For the purposes of this section, "on sale" shall be defined as alcoholic beverages sold by the drink for consumption on the premises of the licensed establishment; "off sale" shall be defined as alcoholic beverages sold at retail in the original container for consumption off the premises of the licensed establishment.

(D) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit licensed premises from being open for other business on days and hours during which the sale or dispensing of alcoholic beverages is prohibited by this section.
