

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 2010-2

AN ORDINANCE TO BE ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF NEHAWKA, CASS COUNTY, REVISING THE PROVISION OF THE VILLAGE CODE RELATING TO HOURS OF SALE FOR ALCOHOL WITHIN THE VILLAGE AND TO REPEAL ORDINANCES CONTRARY THERETO.

BE IT ORDERED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, VILLAGE OF NEHAWKA, CASS COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

- A. No alcoholic liquor, including beer, shall be sold at retail or dispensed on any day between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. The Board of Trustees with respect to area inside the corporate limits of the village may by ordinance require closing prior to 2:00 a.m. on any day.
- B. No Such ordinance shall permit alcoholic liquor, other than beer and wine, to be sold at retail or dispensed between the hours of 6:00 a.m. Sunday and 12:00 noon Sunday. This division (B) shall not apply after 12 noon on Sunday to a licensee which is a nonprofit corporation and the holder of a Class C license or a Class I license.
- C. It shall be unlawful on property licensed to sell alcoholic liquor at retail to allow alcoholic liquor in open containers to remain or be in possession or control of any person for purposes of consumption between the hours of 2:15 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on any day. If the Board of Trustees provides by ordinances for an earlier closing hour, the provisions of this division (c) shall become effective 15 minutes after such closing hour instead of 2:15 a.m.
- D. Nothing in this section shall prohibit licensed premises from being open for other business on days and hours during which the sale or dispensing of alcoholic liquor is prohibited by this section.
