ORDER

Now on the 16th day of December, 2015, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 1st day of December, 2015.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did, on or about September 5, 2015, permit the carrying out from its licensed premise, alcoholic liquor in open containers, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-123.04 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01H of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of five (5) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
3. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
4. That appropriate signage be posted indicating no alcohol past front door.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C-50888 Liquor License of 9500 LLC, DBA – “Downtown-Lazzari’s”, 1430-34 O Street, Lincoln, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of five (5) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 6th day of March, 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 12th day of March, 2016, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Furthermore, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission. Additionally, that appropriate signage be posted indicating no alcohol past front door.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.
