ORDER

Now on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2015, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2015.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:


1. That the licensee did, extend credit in the sale of alcoholic liquor at retail, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-183 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01M of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of ten (10) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class D-91362 Liquor License of Dermer's LLC, DBA - "Dermer's", 1311 E Overland Drive, Scottsbluff, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of ten (10) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2016, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.


