ORDER

Now on the 18th day of November, 2015, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 5th day of November, 2015.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:


1. That the licensed premises, on or about July 30, 2015, was found not to be maintained in a sanitary condition, in violation of 237-LCC6-019.01S of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of five (5) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C Liquor License of Robin D Drews, DBA – “The Dug Out Bar”, 239 E 6th Street, Fremont, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of five (5) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 17th day of January, 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 23rd day of January, 2016, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.


