ORDER

Now on the 1st day of September 2020, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

In accordance with the Commission's policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by regular U.S. Mail.

The licensee was not present nor represented. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:
FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. That the licensee did, on or about November 22, 2019, permit the selling, dispensing or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

- 1. That selling, dispensing or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age, is in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-180 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01A of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
- 2. That the license should be suspended for a period of seventeen (17) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
- 3. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class I Liquor License of Pig and Finch Omaha LLC, DBA - "801 Grill", 10387 Pacific Street, Omaha, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of seventeen (17) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 1st day of November 2020, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 19th day of November 2020, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$79.44.
