ORDER

Now on the 4th day of June 2019, this matter came on for hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission upon an order to show cause whether or not the why the license should not be suspended, cancelled, or revoked due to character and reputation, i.e., Timothy McMullen failed to notify the Commission of:

- 5/2016- DUI

Additionally, for filing false renewals in 2016, 2017 & 2018, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-131.01.

The Licensee was present and represented by Attorney Steve Dowding. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. That the licensee did file false renewals in 2016, 2017, and 2018.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

1. That filing false renewals in 2016, 2017 and 2018 is in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-131.01.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of five (5) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
3. That a condition should be added to the license that Timothy McMullen will not consume alcohol on the premises.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class CK Liquor License of MJR Bandits, DBA – “Bandits”, 1016 Diers Avenue, Suite 118, Grand Island, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of five (5) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 4th day of August 2019, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 10th day of August 2019, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, that a condition should be added to the license that Timothy McMullen will not consume alcohol on the premises.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.
