ORDER

Now on the 8th day of March, 2016, this matter came on for hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

In accordance with the Commission's policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by U.S. Regula Mail

The licensee was not present nor represented. The State was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. That the licensee did, on or about August 27, 2015, permit the selling, dispensing, or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-180 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01A of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

1. That the said sale of alcoholic liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one (21) is in direct violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-180 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01A of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

2. That the license should be suspended for a period of twelve (12) day(s).

3. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C Liquor License of Bryan E Santillan, dba Bandoleros Mexican Sports Bar, 205 N Nebraska Street, Madison NE, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of twelve (12) day(s), such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 29th day of May, 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 11th day of June, 2016. Furthermore, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$174.60.


