ORDER

Now on the 10th day of December 2019, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 21st day of September 2019.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:


1. That the licensee did, on or about September 21st, 2019, permit the selling, dispensing, or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-180 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01A of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the licensee did, on or about September 21st, 2019, sell, dispense, furnish or allow possession of alcoholic liquor to an individual who had become intoxicated by the previous consumption of alcoholic liquor, in violation of 237-LCC6-019.01N of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
3. That the license should be suspended for twelve (12) days on charge #1 and suspended for twenty (20) days on charge #2 for a total period of thirty-two (32) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
4. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C Liquor License of Michael and Mary Tiensvold, DBA – “Barrel House Liquor”, 215 W Highway 20, Rushville, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for twelve (12) days on charge # 1 and suspended for twenty (20) days on charge # 2 for a total period of thirty-two (32) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 16th day of February 2020, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 20th day of March 2020, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$0.00.
