ORDER

Now on the 6th day of September 2023, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

The licensee was present and represented by Attorney Perry Pirsch. The Commission was represented by Ken Yoho, Assistant Attorney General.

A plea of guilty was given upon opening.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:
FINDING OF FACTS:

1. That the licensee did, on or about July 16, 2023, permit the carrying out from its licensed premise, alcoholic liquor in open containers.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

1. That the licensee did, on or about July 16, 2023, permit the carrying out from its licensed premise, alcoholic liquor in open containers, in violation Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-123.04 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01H of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of twenty (20) days, with the option to pay a penalty in lieu thereof.
3. That a condition be placed on the license of no alcohol consumption by owners or employees on the premises.
4. That a condition be placed on the license of no violations for one (1) year from the date of this order.


IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class I Liquor License of Engine House Café on the Lake, DBA – “Boat House Bar & Grill”, 10005 W Davey Rd, Raymond, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of twenty (20) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 27th day of June 2024, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 18th day of July 2024, with the option to pay a penalty in lieu thereof. Furthermore, that a condition be placed on the license of no alcohol consumption by owners or employees and a condition of no violations for one (1) year from the date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$55.06.
