Now on the 9th day of February, 2016, this matter came on for hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission upon an order to show cause why the license should not be suspended, cancelled or revoked, i.e., Investigator Schafer reports that the licensee failed to operate the license for a total of thirty continuous days or sixty total days in violation of 237-LCC6-020.03 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission. Owner Anthony Ditton said he is now going through a divorce and doesn't have the money to pay for his renewed license. (Not picking up from clerk's office).

In accordance with the Commission's policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by regular U.S. mail.

The applicant was not present nor represented. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this matter, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. That the licensee failed to operate the license for a total of thirty continuous days or sixty total days.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

1. That failing to operate the license for a total of thirty continuous days or sixty total days is in direct violation of 237-LCC6-020.03 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be cancelled.


IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class CK-110046 Liquor License of Boulevard 333 LLC, dba "Boulevard Bistro", at 333 N Cotner Blvd, Lincoln, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, cancelled, effective at the closing hour of business on the 8th day of May, 2016.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.


