ORDER

Now on the 9th day of February, 2016, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 23rd day of December, 2015.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did, on or about October 11, 2015, permit the carrying out from its licensed premise, alcoholic liquor in open containers, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-123.04 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01H of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of seven (7) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C Liquor License of 1339 O Street Inc., DBA – “Brothers Bar and Grill”, 1339 O Street, Lincoln, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of seven (7) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 3rd day of April, 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 11th day of April, 2016, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.
