ORDER

Now on the 5th day of June 2018, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 4th day of May 2018.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did, on or about February 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018, sell, dispense, furnish or allow possession of alcoholic liquor to an individual who had become intoxicated by the previous consumption of alcoholic liquor, in violation of 237-LCC6-019.01N of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of twenty (20) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
3. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
4. That Mandatory Meeting should be set before the Commission regarding the licensee's history of violations.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class IK Liquor License of GNS Corporation, DBA – "Cappy's", 5560 S 48 Street Suite 4, Lincoln, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of twenty (20) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 29th day of July 2018, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 19th day of August 2018, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission. Additionally, that a mandatory meeting shall be set before the Commission regarding the licensee's history of violations, such hearing to be held on **Tuesday, July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 1:15 P.M.**, or as soon thereafter as it may be heard.

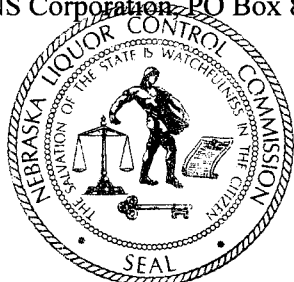
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.
