ORDER

Now on the 7th day of September 2016, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

Attorney Michael Kelley was present on behalf of the licensee. The State was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Based upon the testimony of the witness and the evidence in this case, The Commission finds the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. That the licensee did, on or about March 11, 2016, permit the selling, dispensing or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:


- 1. That the selling, dispensing or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age, is in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-180 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01A of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
- 2. That the license should be suspended for a period of ten (10) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
- 3. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class I Liquor License of Cheddars Casual Café Inc, DBA – “Cheddars Casual Café”, 12152 L Street, Omaha, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of ten (10) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 30th day of October 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 10th day of November 2016, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$120.45.

IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ

To Licensee:

The Order of suspension, to which this Notice is enclosed, provides for a suspension of your license for a period of **ten (10)** days. State Law provides that you may either comply with the Order of suspension and be closed for the prescribed number of days or you may notify the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission and elect to pay a fine of **\$50** per day for the number of days of your suspension and remain open and continue the full operation of your establishment.

If you desire to pay a fine instead of being closed you must sign the below election notification request and mail it to the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, P.O. Box 95046, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509, along with a certified or cashier's check, personal or business check, or U.S. money order made payable to the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission; the election notification must be received by the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission on or before **October 24, 2016**; if the election notification and full payment is not received by the above stated date then you must close your establishment for the sale of alcoholic liquor for the required number of days suspended.
