ORDER

Now on the 10th day of May 2016, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did, on or about November 21, 2015, permit the selling, dispensing or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-180 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01A of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of seven (7) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
3. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class D Liquor License of Cheema Capital LLC, DBA – “Cheema's Gas & Liquor”, 2002 Avenue I, Scottsbluff, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of seven (7) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 26th day of June 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 4th day of July 2016, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$0.00.

Enclosed herewith find closing notices setting forth the dates that your licensed premises are to be closed for the sale of alcoholic liquors.


These notices must be posted by you on your main entrances to your premises and remain there during the period of time you are closed.

The law provides that you may remain open for other business on days during which the sale of alcoholic liquors has been prohibited by your suspension. However, if you are licensed as a pickle card operator with the Nebraska Department of Revenue's Charitable Gaming Division, you cannot sell pickle cards during the period of your liquor license suspension, unless you have paid a fine in lieu of such suspension. Please be advised that the Nebraska Department of Revenue has the jurisdiction to impose its own penalties regarding your pickle card operator's license. If you have any questions, please contact the Charitable Gaming Division, Department of Revenue (402) 471-5937.

You may be ordered by the Commission to complete a certified alcohol server training program. If you must complete training, please review the "Guidelines for Commission Ordered Training" insert enclosed.
