ORDER

Now on the 8th day of January 2019, this matter came on for hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission upon an order to show cause why the license should not be suspended, cancelled or revoked for failure to file a new manager's application within sixty (60) days as required by 237-LCC2-009 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, Additionally, the licensee filed false renewals in 2017 and 2018.

The licensee was present. The State was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Based upon the testimony of the witness and the evidence in this case, The Commission finds the following:

1. That the licensee did, fail to file a new manager's application within sixty (60) days as required by 237-LCC2-009 of the Rules and regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the licensee did file false renewals in 2017 and 2018 in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-131.01.
3. That the license should be suspended for a period of twenty-five (25) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
4. Additionally, that a condition shall be added to the license of no further violations for one (1) year from the date of this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class I Liquor License of McCook Hotel Group LLC, DBA – "Cobblestone Hotel & Suites", 1301 N Highway 83, McCook, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of twenty-five (25) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 3rd day of March 2019, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 29th day of March 2019, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, that a condition shall be added to the license of no further violations for one (1) year from the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.
