ORDER

Now on the 1st day of November, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, to show cause why the license should not be suspended, cancelled, or revoked for failure to comply with a specific Order of the Commission, i.e., failure to file manager's application, as set forth in Commission Order dated September 14, 2016, in violation of 237-LCC1-005.01 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

The licensee was present. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

- 1. That the licensee did fail to comply with a specific Order of the Commission, i.e. training, as set forth in Commission Order dated September 14, 2016, in violation of 237-LCC1-005.01 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
- 2. That the license should be suspended for a period of twenty (20) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
- 3. That the licensee will amend their corporate structure with the Commission within fourteen (14) days from the date of this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class IK Liquor License of Crave Restaurant LLC, DBA – "Crave", 200 S 31 Avenue, Suite 4103, Omaha, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of twenty (20) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 18th day of December 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 8th day of January 2017, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, that the licensee will amend their corporate structure with the Commission within fourteen (14) days from the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.
