ORDER

Now on the 7th day of February 2023, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 13th day of September 2022.

- Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:
1. That the licensee did permit another to operate under their license or to share in the profits from the business, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-149 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01E of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
 2. That the license should be suspended for a period of thirty (30) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
 3. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.


IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C Liquor License of Crossroads Café LLC, DBA – “Crossroads Café LLC”, 116 N Pennsylvania Avenue, Venango, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of thirty (30) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 16th day of April 2023, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 17th day of May 2023, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$0.00.
