ORDER

Now on the 10th day of February, 2016, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 23rd day of December, 2015.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:


1. That the licensee did, on or about September 18, 2015, permit the selling, dispensing, or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age, in violation of Section 53-180 of the Nebraska Statutes and/or 237-LCC6-019.01A of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of ten (10) day(s).
3. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class I Liquor License of Aruma Lounge LLC, dba El Parian Mexican Bar & Grill, 302 S 11<sup>th</sup> Street, Omaha, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of ten (10) day(s), such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 8th day of May, 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 19th day of May, 2016. Additionally, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.
