Now on the 6th day of July 2022, this matter came on for hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, an order to show cause why the license should not be suspended, cancelled or revoked for failure to appear for a mandatory meeting scheduled before the Commission on Tuesday, June 7, 2022, in regard to allowing an intoxicated to consume or possess on January 8, 2022.

In accordance with the Commission's policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by regular U.S. Mail.

The licensee was not present nor represented. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. That the licensee failed to appear to a mandatory meeting scheduled on June 7, 2022, and failed to appear to the show hearing scheduled on July 6, 2022.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

- 1. That the license shall be cancelled.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class I Liquor License of El Pollo Tote LLC dba "El Pollo Tote", 5007-5009 Grover Street, Omaha, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, cancelled, effective at the closing hour of business on the 21st day of August 2022.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$35.00.
