ORDER

Now on the 7th day of December 2021, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, upon a request for reconsideration having been filed by Jose Ortiz, dba "Epicentro", 248 N Main Street, Fremont Nebraska, said license having been previously cancelled by this Commission in Order dated November 10, 2021.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. The Order of cancellation should be rescinded.
1. That the licensee did purchase, receive, acquire, or possess alcoholic liquors from persons not authorized to sell to the licensee, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-175.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of ten (10) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
3. That the licensee shall pay excise tax of \$13.66 within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order.
4. That the alcohol seized during this investigation shall be destroyed by the Nebraska State Patrol in accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. 53-1,113.
5. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.


IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class D Liquor License of Jose Ortiz, DBA – "Epicentro", 248 N Main Street, Fremont, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of ten (10) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 20th day of February 2022, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 3rd day of March 2022, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, that the licensee shall pay excise tax of \$13.66 within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, and that alcohol seized during this investigation shall be destroyed by the Nebraska State Patrol in accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. 53-1,113. Furthermore, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$35.00.
