Now on the 6th day of July 2016, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, to show cause why the license should not be cancelled for failing to complete the licensing process by paying such appropriate fees and obtaining such license within twenty-one calendar days. License renewal was received on March 18, 2016 by Daniel Stump. New liquor license was mailed to the city clerk's office around April 1, 2016 for pickup. Liquor license was never picked up, in violation of 237-LCC6-020.02 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

In accordance with the Commission's policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by regular U.S. Mail.

The licensee was not present nor represented. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. That the licensee did fail to complete the licensing process by not paying such appropriate fees and not obtaining such license within twenty-one calendar days.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

- 1. Failing to complete the licensing process is in violation of 237-LCC6-020.02 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
- 2. That the license should be cancelled.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class D Liquor License of Fast Phil Plaza Inc., dba Fast Phil Plaza, 405 Second Street, Kearney, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, cancelled, effective at the closing hour of business on the 14th day of August, 2016.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.
