ORDER

Now on the 1st day of November 2016, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

Attorney Sean Kelley was present on behalf of licensee. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:
FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. That the licensee did, on or about February 19, 2016, permit the carrying out from its licensed premise, alcoholic liquor in open containers.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That permitting the carrying out from its licensed premise, alcoholic liquor in open containers, is in violation Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-123.04 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01H of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of two (2) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class I Liquor License of Flagship Commons LLC, DBA – “Flagship Commons”, 10000 California Street, Ste FC01, Omaha, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of two (2) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 18th day of December 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 21st day of December 2016, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.
