ORDER

Now on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2016, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of no contest, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2016.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this matter, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did, on or about October 16, 2015, permit the selling, dispensing, or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-180 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01A of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of ten (10) day(s), with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
3. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.


IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class D Liquor License of Henderson Fuel Stop Inc., dba "Fuel Mart Express", 908 Road B, Henderson, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of ten (10) days(s), such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2016. Furthermore, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$0.00.
