ORDER

Now on the 7th day of June 2022, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 4th day of May 2022.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did, on or about December 12, 2021, permit or allow an individual being less than 21 years of age, to consume or have in his/her possession alcoholic liquor, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-180.02 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01B of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the licensee did, on or about December 12, 2021, permit or knowingly allow conduct on or about the licensed premise in violation of 237-LCC6-019.01Q of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, i.e., violation of local ordinance related to entertainment, (no minors after 9 p.m.).
3. That the license should be suspended for twenty-five (25) days on charge #1 and suspended for ten (10) days on charge # 2 for a total period of thirty-five (35) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
4. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class I Liquor License of Havana Night LLC, DBA – “Havana Night”, 1403 S Eddy Street, Grand Island, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for twenty-five (25) days on charge #1 and suspended for ten (10) days on charge #2 for a total period of thirty-five (35) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 14th day of August 2022, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 19th day of September 2022, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$0.00.


