ORDER

Now on the 5th day of April 2022, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

The licensee was present. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. That the licensee did, on or about November 4, 2021, sell, dispense, furnish or allow possession of alcoholic liquor to an individual who had become intoxicated by the previous consumption of alcoholic liquor.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

- 1. That selling, dispensing, furnishing, or allowing possession of alcoholic liquor to an individual who had become intoxicated by the previous consumption of alcoholic liquor, is in violation of 237-LCC6-019.01N of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
- 2. That the license should be suspended for a period of fifteen (15) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.


IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class CK Liquor License of Gilbert Rivera, DBA – “House Bar”, 1601 E 4th Street, North Platte, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of fifteen (15) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 22nd day of May 2022, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 7th day of June 2022, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$35.00. Additionally, that the Licensee shall pay costs assessed in the amount of \$35.00 for March hearings for a total of \$70.00.
