ORDER

Now on the 9th day of February, 2016, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charge filed on the 23rd day of December, 2015.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did purchase, receive, acquire, accept or possess alcoholic liquors from persons not authorized to sell to the licensee, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-175.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of five (5) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class I Liquor License of Fu Shun Inc., DBA – "Imperial Palace", 701 N 27 Street, Lincoln, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of five (5) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 3rd day of April, 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 9th day of April, 2016, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.
