ORDER

Now on the 12th day of October 2016, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

The licensee was present and represented by Attorney Thomas Klein. The State was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon opening of the hearing, the licensee entered a plea of guilty to the charges.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did permit another person or persons to operate under their license, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-149 and/or 237-LCC6019.01E of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the licensee did on or about March 10, 2016, purchase, receive, acquire, accept, or possess alcoholic liquors from persons not authorized to sell to the licensee, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-175.
3. On Charge # 1: That a new Manager application is to be filed with the Commission within fourteen (14) days of the date of the Order or the License will be cancelled.
4. That the license should be suspended for a period of five (5) days on Charge # 2, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C Liquor License of Kolac Korner LLC, DBA – “Kolac Korner”, 321 West Center Ave, Prague, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of five (5) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 27th day of November 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 3rd day of December 2016, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof on Charge #2. Additionally, on Charge #1, that a new manager application is to be filed within fourteen (14) days of the date of the Order or license will be cancelled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.
