ORDER

Now on the 9th day of August 2016, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, upon a request for reconsideration of penalty having been filed by Lighthouse Restaurants LLC, dba "Lighthouse Pizza", 1004 S 74 Plaza, Omaha, Nebraska, said licensee having been previously suspended by this Commission for a period of two (2) days mandatory closure + forty (40) days suspension with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof, in Order dated May 11, 2016.

The licensee was present and represented by Attorney Michael Kelley. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. That the licensee did, on or about September 18, 2015 permit the selling, dispensing, or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That permitting the selling, dispensing, or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age is in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-180 and/or 237-LCC6-019.01A of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be suspended for two (2) days mandatory closure, and suspended for an additional fifteen (15) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
3. That there will be no violations at the premise for 24 months from the date of this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C Liquor License of Lighthouse Restaurants LLC, dba Lighthouse Pizza, 1004 S 74 Plaza, Omaha, NE, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for two (2) days mandatory closure, and suspended for an additional fifteen (15) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof, such mandatory closure to be October 3rd, 2016 and October 4th, 2016; and the additional fifteen (15) days suspension to commence on October 5th, 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 20th day of October 2016. Additionally, that there will be no violations at the premise for 24 months from the date of this Order.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$55.14.


