ORDER

Now on the 17th day of December 2015, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

The licensee was present. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Based upon the testimony of the witness and the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds the following:

FINDINGS OF FACTS:

- 1. That the licensee did, on or about August 8, 2015, permit the selling, dispensing, or giving away of alcoholic liquor, to or for an individual being less than 21 years of age.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

- 2. That the said sale of alcoholic liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one (21) is in direct violation of Section 53-180 of the Nebraska Statutes and/or 237-LCC6-019.01A of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
- 3. That the license should be suspended for a period of five (5) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.
- 4. That the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C Liquor License of Little Polonia Inc, DBA – “Little Polonia Bar”, 3804 Q Street, Omaha, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of five (5) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 20th of March 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 26th day of March 2016, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof. Additionally, that the licensee and all staff shall complete an approved alcohol server training program within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and shall show certification with complying with the provision of 237-LCC14-004 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$180.30.
