Now on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of July 2019, this matter came on for hearing before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission upon an order to show cause why the license should not be suspended, cancelled or revoked for failure to file a new manager's application within sixty (60) days as required by 237-LCC2-009 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

In accordance with the Commission's policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by regular U.S. Mail.

The licensee was not present nor represented. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. That the licensee fail to file a new manager's application within sixty (60) days.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

- 1. That failing to file a new manager's application within sixty (60) days as required is in violation of 237-LCC2-009 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
- 2. That the license should be cancelled.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class I Liquor License of White Elephant LLC. dba "Mai Thai II", 2279 S 67<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite B, Omaha, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, cancelled, effective at the closing hour of business on the 15th day of September 2019.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.
