ORDER

Now on the 10th day of August 2016, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

In accordance with the Commission's policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by U.S. Regular Mail.

The licensee was not present nor represented. The State was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Based upon the testimony of the witness and the evidence in this case, The Commission finds the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. That the licensee did file a renewal for a license after the date prescribed by law.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

- 1. That filing a renewal after the date prescribed by law is in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-135 and/or 237-LCC1-008 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
- 2. That the license should be suspended for a period of three (3) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.


IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class I Liquor License of Marrakech Inc. dba Marrakech Gourmet, 504 N 33 Street, Omaha, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of three (3) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 25th day of September 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 29th day of September 2016, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.


