Now on the 12th day of April, 2016, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, to show cause why the license should not be suspended, cancelled or revoked for failure to file a new managers application within the required time in violation of 237-LCC-009.01 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

In accordance with the Commission's policies, a proper notice of this hearing was sent by regular U.S. Mail.

The licensee was not present nor represented. The Commission was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. That the licensee failed to file a new manager's application within sixty (60) days

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

1. Failing to file a new manager's application within the required time in violation of 237-LCC2-009.01 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be cancelled.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C Liquor License of Veterans Foreign Wars 6930, dba VFW Post 6330, 120 North Commercial Street, Maywood, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, cancelled, effective at the closing hour of business on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2016.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$25.00.
