ORDER

Now on the 9th day of February 2016, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the licensee having executed a voluntary appearance, waiver of public hearing, plea of guilty, and consent to judgment, in regard to the charges filed on the 15th day of January, 2016.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:

1. That the licensee did file a renewal for licence after the date prescribed by law, in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-135 and/or 237-LCC1-008 of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the license should be suspended for a period of one (1) day(s), with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class C Liquor License of Terry E Mencl, DBA – "MencI's Tavern", 4 Street & 2 Avenue, Virginia, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of one (1) day(s), such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 24th day of April, 2016, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 26th day of April, 2016, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$0.00.
