**ORDER**

Now on the 10th day of July 2018, this matter came on for consideration before the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, notice having been served upon the licensee to appear and respond to an administrative citation alleging that the license should be suspended, cancelled or revoked as more fully set out herein.

The licensee was present and represented by Attorney John Sohl. The State was represented by Milissa Johnson-Wiles, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon opening of the hearing, the licensee entered a plea of guilty to charge #2.

Upon consideration of all the evidence in this case, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission finds:  
FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. That the licensee did, on or about March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018, refuse to permit or unreasonably delay in permitting any law enforcement officers to enter the licensed premises to inspect such premises to determine if the licensee was violating any provisions of the Act or Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That the licensee did, on or about March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018, permit open containers of alcoholic liquor to remain or to be in possession or control of persons for the purposes of consumption after 2:15 a.m.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

1. That refusing to permit or unreasonably in permitting any law enforcement officers to enter the licensed premises to inspect such premises to determine if the licensee was violating any provisions of the Act or Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, is in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-134(2) and/or 237-LCC6-019.01G of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
2. That permitting open containers of alcoholic liquor to remain or to be in possession or control of persons for the purposes of consumption after 2:15 a.m., is in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sec. 53-179(3) and/or 237-LCC6-019.01D of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.
3. That the license should be suspended for a period of fifteen (15) days, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof.


IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Retail Class CK Liquor License of Brewnowski's Tavern LLC, DBA – "Mike's Bar and Grill", 182 N 2 Street, Dwight, Nebraska, should be, and the same hereby is, suspended for a period of fifteen (15) days, such suspension to commence at the closing hour of business on the 9th day of September 2018, and to continue until the opening hour of business on the 25th day of September 2018, with the option to pay a fine in lieu thereof

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the notice of suspension shall be posted upon the premises, said notice to remain posted throughout the term of said suspension.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Licensee shall pay costs of this action, assessed in the amount of \$83.33.
