

Renewal Publication Reminder - Class “C” Licenses:

53-135.01. Retail licenses; renewal; notice. The city, village, or county clerk shall cause to be published in a legal newspaper in or of general circulation in such city, village, or county, one time between January 10 and January 30 of each year, individual notice of the right of automatic renewal of each retail liquor and beer license, except that notice of the right of automatic renewal of Class C licenses shall be published between the dates of July 10 and July 30 of each year within such city, village, or county, in substantially the following form:

NOTICE OF RENEWAL OF RETAIL LIQUOR LICENSE

Notice is hereby given pursuant to section 53-135.01 that a liquor license may be automatically renewed for one year from May 1, 20...., or November 1, 20...., for the following retail liquor licensee:

Notice is hereby given that written protests to the issuance of automatic renewal of license may be filed by any resident of the city (village or county) on or before February 10, 20...., or August 10, 20...., in the office of the city (village or county) clerk and that in the event protests are filed by three or more such persons, hearing will be had to determine whether continuation of the license should be allowed.





Upon the conclusion of any hearing required by this section, the local governing body may request a licensee to submit an application as provided in section 53-135.

SDL News

Reminder: Licensees that have a “K” catering endorsement on their liquor license are not exempt from filing Special Designated License Applications. When catering events with alcohol off their licensed premise, the licensee would still need to file for a Special Designated License. This license would need to be displayed at the event.

Growlers

Applications that would include a growler endorsement would include the letter “G” along with the Class of license. No fees are to be collected at the local level for this endorsement.

Additions, Deletions, Reconstructions:

For these types of applications, local approval may be obtained prior to submittal. It would be extremely helpful if you could give the applicant a copy of your approval. The applicant can then submit your approval with their application for processing. This will significantly help to expedite the approvals process. We will then only need to send out notifications to Fire, Agriculture, and State Patrol.
