

## ORDINANCE #385

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEAVER CITY, NEBRASKA, AMENDING CHAPTER IV ARTICLE III, SECTION 4-305 HOURS OF SALE, OF THE REVISED MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF BEAVER CITY, NEBRASKA; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREIN IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF JULY 19, 2010.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BEAVER CITY, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

### SECTION 4-305:


No person shall sell at retail or wholesale or dispense any alcoholic liquor, including beer, on Sunday between the hours of 1:00 a.m. on Sunday and 12:00 midnight on Sunday within the corporate limits of the City; provided that such limitations shall not apply after 12:00 noon on Sunday to a licensee which is a nonprofit corporation holding license pursuant to Section 53-124(5)(C)& (H), R.R.S. Neb. 1943.

No alcoholic liquors, including beer and wine, shall be sold at retail or dispensed on secular days between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. All alcoholic liquors, including beer and wine, shall be off the tables and bars by fifteen (15) minutes after closing, and all persons excluding owners and employees shall be off the premises by thirty (30) minutes after closing.

Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit licensed premises from being open for other business on day and hours during which the sale or dispensing of alcoholic beverages is prohibited by this section.
