RESOLUTION #2015- 10

**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AND PERMIT
RETAIL SALE OR DISPENSING OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR
FOR CONSUMPTION ON PREMISES
LATER THAN 1:00 A.M. AND PRIOR TO 2:00 A.M.
ON SPECIFIED DAYS OF THE WEEK.**

WHEREAS, Section 53-179 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes of 1943, R.R.S. 2014, specifically provides for the applicable hours for sale and dispensing of alcoholic liquors by retail licensees; and,

WHEREAS, said Section furthermore under subsection (1), grants to the local governing body, particularly the Thomas County Board of Commissioners, the determination of whether or not to permit alcoholic liquors other than beer and wine, to be sold at retail or dispensed later than 1:00 A.M. and prior to 2:00 A.M. on any day of the week; and,

WHEREAS, a licensee located within Thomas County, Nebraska, and outside the corporate limits of any city or village, has requested consideration of expansion of sales as provided by said statute; and,

WHEREAS, in order to approve the same, a two-thirds vote of the members of the County Board of Thomas County, Nebraska, must vote in favor of expanded hours.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF THOMAS COUNTY, NEBRASKA, that, pursuant to Section 53-179 (1), the County Board of Thomas County, Nebraska, does hereby approve and permit retail sale or dispensing of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises, excluding sales for consumption off of the premises, between the hours of 1:00 A.M. and 2:00 A.M., on the following days of the week, to-wit:


