ORDINANCE NO. 01-02-2011

NEBRASKA LIQUOR
CONTROL COMMISSION

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CARLETON, NEBRASKA PERMITTING RETAIL SALE OR DISPENSING OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES, EXCLUDING SALES FOR CONSUMPTION OFF THE PREMISES, UNTIL 2:00 A.M.

WHEREAS, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 53-179, as amended, provides that the local governing body of any village, with respect to area inside the corporate limits of such village, may by ordinance, if adopted by a vote of at least two-thirds of the members of such local governing body, permit retail sale or dispensing of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises, excluding sales for consumption off the premises, later than 1:00 a.m. and prior to 2:00 a.m. on any day;

WHEREAS, the Village finds it expedient to approve such liquor sales until 2:00 a.m. within the Village limits;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRPERSON AND MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CARLETON, THAYER COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the retail sale or dispensing of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises, excluding sales for consumption off the premises, by such establishments with valid liquor licenses, be allowed later than 1:00 a.m. and prior to 2:00 a.m., in accordance with Nebraska law.

Section 2: That all ordinances, resolutions and Code sections or portions thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after publication as provided by law, and shall be published in pamphlet form.
