NEBRASKA LIQUOR
CONTROL COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Section 53-179 (1)(a) of the Nebraska Revised Statutes allows the governing body of the Village to adopt, by a vote of at least two-thirds of its members, a resolution to permit retail sales or dispensing of alcoholic liquor for the consumption on the premises, excluding sales for consumption off the premises, later than 1 A.M. and prior to 2 A.M. on any day;

And **WHEREAS**, the Village Chairman and the Village Board of the Village of Cornlea, Platte County, Nebraska wish to adopt a resolution permitting retail sale or dispensing of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises until 2:00 AM on any day beginning March 3, 2014.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Chairman and Village Council of the Village of Cornlea, Platte County, Nebraska to:

Permit retail sales or dispensing of alcoholic liquor for the consumption on the premises, excluding sales for consumption off the premises until 2:00 A.M. on any day beginning March 3, 2014.
