ORDINANCE NO. 489

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE HOURS OF SALE FOR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; TO EXTEND THE HOURS OF SALE FOR ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS, BEER, AND WINE, ON SALE ONLY, FROM 1:00 A.M. TO 2:00 A.M.; TO PROVIDE FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DAYKIN, JEFFERSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1: That Chapter 11, Article 111, Section 111-48, of the Municipal Code of the Village of Daykin, Jefferson County, Nebraska, be amended to read as follows:

111.48 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; HOURS OF SALE. (1) It shall be unlawful for any licensed person or persons or their agents to sell any alcoholic beverages within the Municipality except during the hours provided herein:

HOURS OF SALE

Alcoholic Liquors (except beer and wine)

Secular Days

Off Sale.....6:00 A.M. to 1:00 A.M.  
On Sale.....6:00 A.M. to 2:00 A.M.

Sundays

Off Sale.....12:00 Noon to 1:00 A.M.  
On Sale.....12:00 Noon to 2:00 A.M.

Beer and Wine

Secular Days

Off Sale.....6:00 A.M. to 1:00 A.M.  
On Sale.....6:00 A.M. to 2:00 A.M.

Sundays

Off Sale.....6:00 A.M. to 1:00 A.M.  
On Sale.....6:00 A.M. to 2:00 A.M.

(2) No person or persons shall consume any alcoholic beverages on licensed premises for a period of time longer than fifteen (15) minutes after the time


fixed herein for stopping the sale of alcoholic beverages on the said premises. For the purposes of this section, "on sale" shall be defined as alcoholic beverages sold by the drink for consumption on the premises of the licensed establishment; "off sale" shall be defined as alcoholic beverages sold at retail in the original container for consumption off the premises of the licensed establishment.

- (3) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit licensed premises from being open for other business on days and hours during which the sale or dispensing of alcoholic beverages is prohibited by this section.

Section 2. That any other ordinance or section passed and approved prior to passage, approval, and publication or posting of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon passage and approval.
