ORDINANCE 325

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF HARBINE, JEFFERSON COUNTING, NEBRASKA AUTHORIZING AND PERMITTING THE RETAIL SALE OR DISPENSING OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR FOR CONSUMPTION OFF THE PREMISES LATER THAN 1:00 A.M. AND PRIOR TO 2:00 A.M. ON ANY DAY AS AUTHORIZED BY LB 863 §77 OF THE NEBRASKA LEGISLATURE, LAWS 2014, EFFECTIVE DATE OCTOBER 6, 2014.

WHEREAS, the Nebraska Legislature adopted LB 863 §24, Laws 2014, giving the cities and villages the option to extend the closing hour for sale of alcoholic beverages, including beer, for off-site consumption from 1:00 A.M. to prior to 2:00 A.M. on any day of the week; and

WHEREAS, the extension of the time for off premises sale of alcoholic beverages to prior to 2:00 A.M. must be adopted by a vote of at least two thirds of the members of the local governing body.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF HARBINE THAT:

As authorized by LB 863, of the 2014 Nebraska State Legislature, the Village of Harbine, by the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of its membership, does hereby authorize and approve the extension of the hours during which alcoholic beverages, including beer, may be sold for consumption off premises to prior to 2:00 A.M. on any day of the week as of the adoption of this ordinance and publication according to law.

PASSED AND APPROVED by at least two-thirds of the membership of the Village Board of Harbine, Jefferson County, Nebraska on the 6th day of October, 2014.
